exclusive international fashion experience," she said.

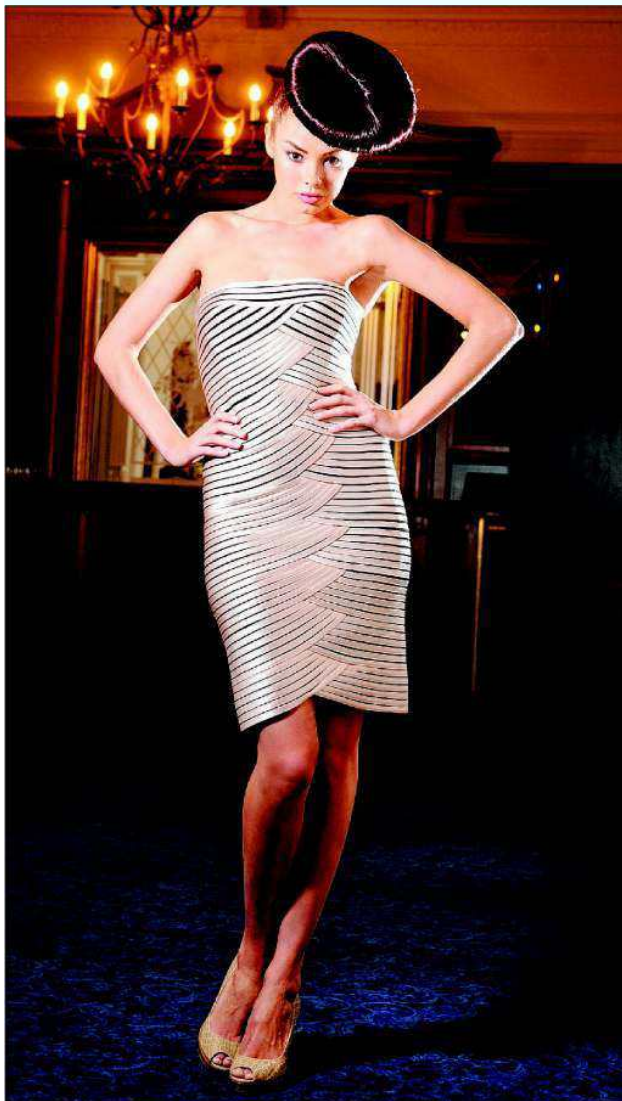
